

## cfUniForm v2.4 - Bug Fixes

The v2.4 release of the [cfUniForm tag library](#) - a library of ColdFusion custom tags for quick and easy generation of XHTML 1.0 Strict compliant forms - is being made to address a couple of minor bug fixes. This will only affect forms with a class of 'blockLabels' on the fieldset, or forms that use 'top' on the 'errorMessagePlacement' attribute.


### CSS Bug Fix

In previous releases, there was a CSS bug when using 'blockLabels' on your fieldset, which caused any element hints to appear partially below and off to the right of the field.

### errorMessagePlacement="top" Bug Fix

In previous releases, there was a bug which caused the opening <div> tag on an element's control holder to not be rendered when using 'top' on the error message placement. This release fixes that issue.
