

cfUniForm v4.1 - Minor Release Update to Uni-Form 1.4

I just released cfUniForm 4.1 on RIAForge. As far as cfUniForm is concerned, this is a minor release done for the specific purpose of updating cfUniForm with the latest release (1.4) of the Uni-Form markup and CSS spec. On the other hand, for those who have been seeking themed CSS with cfUniForm, you will be happy to know that this release is for that exact purpose.

What's New?

There is a new 'uniformThemeCSS' configuration key available on the 'pathConfig' attribute for the form tag. This defaults to the default Uni-Form theme, but you can change this in your application if so desired. Three themes now ship with cfUniForm (thanks to [Dragan Babic](#)):

- Default
- Blue
- Dark

What has changed?

If you are using the default CSS with cfUniForm, then you have no changes to make in your applications. If, however, you are using an altered version of the CSS that ships with cfUniForm, there is a possibility that you will see some differences in your displays, as the markup has changed slightly in a couple of places. **Please be sure to test the new version in your application before switching!**

If you want to create a new theme, copy '/commonassets/css/uni-form.default.css' and use it to create your new theme file.
